**Kingdom of heaven = the Church**

Treasure: cf:

Exodus 19:5-6 Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth *is* mine: 19:6 And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These *are* the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

Field = The World cf:

Matt 13:38 The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked *one;* 

A man = Jesus cf:

Matt 13:37 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man.

Found = Jesus' purpose for in coming into the world cf:

Luke 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

Hideth = cf:

Psalms 17:8 Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

The joy thereof = it was a joy for Christ to die for you. Cf:

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
