- V: 27 **We have forsaken all ...**. What is the reward for a lifetime of discipleship?
- V: 29 (A) It just doesn't get any better than: you will *inherit eternal life!*It's a *hundredfold* better than anything you have ever seen with your eyes, heard about with your ears or imagined in your heart. I Corinthians 2:9
- V: 30 What JESUS has accomplished in His life, death, burial and resurrection The Gospel would be for all who are *In*Christ so first or last is irrelevant.
